

## ISRAEL MUST CRY OUT TO THE MOST HIGH TO BE SAVED FROM CAPTIVITY 2

**Leviticus 19:32** Thou shalt rise up before the hoary head, and honour the face of the old man, and fear thy God: I am the LORD.

**1 Timothy 5:1** Rebuke not an elder, but intreat him as a father; and the younger men as brethren;

**Job 8:8** For enquire, I pray thee, of the former age, and prepare thyself to the search of their fathers:

**Numbers 15:38** Speak unto the children of Israel, and bid them that they make them fringes in the borders of their garments throughout their generations, and that they put upon the fringe of the borders a ribband of blue:

**Numbers 15:39** And it shall be unto you for a fringe, that ye may look upon it, and remember all the commandments of the LORD, and do them; and that ye seek not after your own heart and your own eyes, after which ye use to go a whoring:

**Exodus 22:26** If thou at all take thy neighbour's raiment to pledge, thou shalt deliver it unto him by that the sun goeth down:

**Exodus 22:27** For that is his covering only, it is his raiment for his skin: wherein shall he sleep? and it shall come to pass, when he crieth unto me, that I will hear; for I am gracious.

**Deuteronomy 32:16** They provoked him to jealousy with strange gods, with abominations provoked they him to anger.

**Deuteronomy 32:17** They sacrificed unto devils, not to God; to gods whom they knew not, to new gods that came newly up, whom your fathers feared not.

**Deuteronomy 32:20** And he said, I will hide my face from them, I will see what their end shall be: for they are a very froward generation, children in whom is no faith.

**Psalms 106:35** But were mingled among the heathen, and learned their works.

**Psalms 106:36** And they served their idols: which were a snare unto them.

**Psalms 106:37** Yea, they sacrificed their sons and their daughters unto devils,

**Psalms 106:38** And shed innocent blood, even the blood of their sons and of their daughters, whom they sacrificed unto the idols of Canaan: and the land was polluted with blood.

[The Book of Baruch 4:15](#) For he hath brought a nation upon them from far, a shameless nation, and of a strange language, who neither revered old man, nor pitied child.

[The Book of Baruch 4:16](#) These have carried away the dear beloved children of the widow, and left her that was alone desolate without daughters.

[The Book of Baruch 4:17](#) But what can I help you?

[The Book of Baruch 4:18](#) For he that brought these plagues upon you will deliver you from the hands of your enemies.

**Luke 1:68** Blessed be the Lord God of Israel; for he hath visited and redeemed his people,

**Luke 1:69** And hath raised up an horn of salvation for us in the house of his servant David;

**Judges 6:14** And the LORD looked upon him, and said, Go in this thy might, and thou shalt save Israel from the hand of the Midianites: have not I sent thee?

**Judges 6:15** And he said unto him, Oh my Lord, wherewith shall I save Israel? behold, my family is poor in Manasseh, and I am the least in my father's house.

**Judges 6:16** And the LORD said unto him, Surely I will be with thee, and thou shalt smite the Midianites as one man.

**Judges 10:10** And the children of Israel cried unto the LORD, saying, We have sinned against thee, both because we have forsaken our God, and also served Baalim.

**Judges 10:11** And the LORD said unto the children of Israel, Did not I deliver you from the Egyptians, and from the Amorites, from the children of Ammon, and from the Philistines?

**Judges 10:12** The Zidonians also, and the Amalekites, and the Maonites, did oppress you; and ye cried to me, and I delivered you out of their hand.

**Judges 10:13** Yet ye have forsaken me, and served other gods: wherefore I will deliver you no more.

**Judges 10:14** Go and cry unto the gods which ye have chosen; let them deliver you in the

**Exodus 14:10** And when Pharaoh drew nigh, the children of Israel lifted up their eyes, and, behold, the Egyptians marched after them; and they were sore afraid: and the children of Israel cried out unto the LORD.

**Exodus 14:13** And Moses said unto the people, Fear ye not, stand still, and see the salvation of the LORD, which he will show to you to day: for the Egyptians whom ye have seen to day, ye shall see them again no more for ever.

**Exodus 14:14** The LORD shall fight for you, and ye shall hold your peace.

**Exodus 14:15** And the LORD said unto Moses, Wherefore criest thou unto me? speak unto the children of Israel, that they go forward:

**Exodus 14:16** But lift thou up thy rod, and stretch out thine hand over the sea, and divide it: and the children of Israel shall go on dry ground through the midst of the sea.

**1 Corinthians 10:4** And did all drink the same spiritual drink: for they drank of that spiritual Rock that followed them: and that Rock was Christ.

**Exodus 15:23** And when they came to Marah, they could not drink of the waters of Marah, for they were bitter: therefore the name of it was called Marah.

**Psalms 105:10** And confirmed the same unto Jacob for a law, and to Israel for an

everlasting covenant:

**Psalms 148:14** He also exalteth the horn of his people, the praise of all his saints; even of the children of Israel, a people near unto him. Praise ye the LORD.

**Psalms 149:1** Praise ye the LORD. Sing unto the LORD a new song, and his praise in the congregation of saints.

**Psalms 149:2** Let Israel rejoice in him that made him: let the children of Zion be joyful in their King.

**2 Thessalonians 1:11** Wherefore also we pray always for you, that our God would count you worthy of this calling, and fulfil all the good pleasure of his goodness, and the work of faith with power:

**2 Thessalonians 1:12** That the name of our Lord Jesus Christ may be glorified in you, and ye in him, according to the grace of our God and the Lord Jesus Christ.
