

PRIEST THAAHWAM 3: Zephaniah 3:9 For then will I turn to the people a pure language, that they may all call upon the name of the LORD, to serve him with one consent.

PRIEST THAAHWAM 3: Revelation 2:9 I know thy works, and tribulation, and poverty, (but thou art rich) and I know the blasphemy of them which say they are Jews, and are not, but are the synagogue of Satan.

PRIEST THAAHWAM 3: Revelation 3:9 Behold, I will make them of the synagogue of Satan, which say they are Jews, and are not, but do lie; behold, I will make them to come and worship before thy feet, and to know that I have loved thee.

PRIEST THAAHWAM 3: Zechariah 9:6 And a bastard shall dwell in Ashdod, and I will cut off the pride of the Philistines.

PRIEST THAAHWAM 3: THE PHYSICAL CAPTIVITY OF THE HEBREW ISRAELITES

PRIEST THAAHWAM 3: Joshua 24:17 For the LORD our God, he it is that brought us up and our fathers out of the land of Egypt, from the house of bondage, and which did those great signs in our sight, and preserved us in all the way wherein we went, and among all the people through whom we passed:

PRIEST THAAHWAM 3: Joshua 24:18 And the LORD drave out from before us all the people, even the Amorites which dwelt in the land: therefore will we also serve the LORD; for he is our God.

PRIEST THAAHWAM 3: Joshua 24:19 And Joshua said unto the people, Ye cannot see h are among you, and incline your heart unto the LORD God of Israel.

PRIEST THAAHWAM 3: Joshua 24:24 And the people said unto Joshua, The LORD our God will we serve, and his voice will we obey.

PRIEST THAAHWAM 3: Joshua 24:25 So Joshua made a covenant with the people that day, and set them a statute and an ordinance in Shechem.

PRIEST THAAHWAM 3: Joshua 24:26 And Joshua wrote these words in the book of the law of God, and took a great stone, and set it up there under an oak, that was by the sanctuary of the LORD.

PRIEST THAAHWAM 3: Joshua 24:27 And Joshua said unto all the people, Behold, this stone shall be a witness unto us; for it hath heard all the words of the LORD which he spake unto us: it shall be therefore a witness unto you, lest ye deny your God.

PRIEST THAAHWAM 3: Joshua 24:28 So Joshua let the people depart, every man unto his inheritance.

PRIEST THAAHWAM 3: Judges 2:1 And an angel of the LORD came up from Gilgal to Bochim, and said, I made you to go up out of Egypt, and have brought you unto the land which I swore unto your fathers; and I said, I will never break my covenant with you.

PRIEST THAAHWAM 3: Exodus 3:2 And the angel of the LORD appeared unto him in a flame of fire out of the midst of a bush: and he looked, and, behold, the bush burned with fire, and the bush was not consumed.

PRIEST THAAHWAM 3: Psalms 104:4 Who maketh his angels spirits; his ministers a flaming fire:

PRIEST THAAHWAM 3: Jeremiah 23:29 Is not my word like as a fire? saith the LORD; and like a hammer that breaketh the rock in pieces?

PRIEST THAAHWAM 3: Revelation 1:1 The Revelation of Jesus Christ, which God gave unto him, to shew unto his servants things which must shortly come to pass; and he sent and signified it by his angel unto his servant John:

PRIEST THAAHWAM 3: Isaiah 44:1 Yet now hear, O Jacob my servant; and Israel, whom I have chosen:

PRIEST THAAHWAM 3: Isaiah 44:2 Thus saith the LORD that made thee, and formed thee from the womb, which will help thee; Fear not, O Jacob, my servant; and thou, Jesurun, whom I have chosen.

PRIEST THAAHWAM 3: Judges 2:1 And an angel of the LORD came up from Gilgal to Bochim, and said, I made you to go up out of Egypt, and have brought you unto the land which I swore unto your fathers; and I said, I will never break my covenant with you.

PRIEST THAAHWAM 3: John 16:13 Howbeit when he, the Spirit of truth, is come, he will guide you into all truth: for he shall not speak of himself; but whatsoever he shall hear, that shall he speak: and he will shew you things to come.

PRIEST THAAHWAM 3: Judges 2:1 And an angel of the LORD came up from Gilgal to Bochim, and said, I made you to go up out of Egypt, and have brought you unto the land which I swore unto your fathers; and I said, I will never break my covenant with you.

PRIEST THAAHWAM 3: 1 Corinthians 10:1 Moreover, brethren, I would not that ye should be ignorant, how that all our fathers were under the cloud, and all passed through the sea;

PRIEST THAAHWAM 3: 1 Corinthians 10:2 And were all baptized unto Moses in the cloud and in the sea;

PRIEST THAAHWAM 3: 1 Corinthians 10:3 And did all eat the same spiritual meat;

PRIEST THAAHWAM 3: 1 Corinthians 10:4 And did all drink the same spiritual drink: for they drank of that spiritual Rock that followed them: and that Rock was Christ.

PRIEST THAAHWAM 3: 1 Corinthians 10:9 Neither let us tempt Christ, as some of them also tempted, and were destroyed of serpents.

PRIEST THAAHWAM 3: 1 Corinthians 3:23 And ye are Christ's; and Christ is God's.

PRIEST THAAHWAM 3: Judges 2:2 And ye shall make no league with the inhabitants of this land; ye shall throw down their altars: but ye have not obeyed my voice: why have ye done this?

PRIEST THAAHWAM 3: Judges 2:3 Wherefore I also said, I will not drive them out from before you; but they shall be as thorns in your sides, and their gods shall be a snare unto you.

PRIEST THAAHWAM 3: Judges 2:7 And the people served the LORD all the days of Joshua, and all the days of the elders that outlived Joshua, who had seen all the great works of the LORD, that he did for Israel.

PRIEST THAAHWAM 3: Judges 2:8 And Joshua the son of Nun, the servant of the LORD, died, being an hundred and ten years old.

PRIEST THAAHWAM 3: Judges 2:10 And also all that generation were gathered unto their fathers: and there arose another generation after them, which knew not the LORD, nor yet the works which he had done for Israel.

PRIEST THAAHWAM 3: Psalms 78:5 For he established a testimony in Jacob, and appointed a law in Israel, which he commanded our fathers, that they should make them known to their children:

PRIEST THAAHWAM 3: Psalms 78:6 That the generation to come might know them, even the children which should be born; who should arise and declare them to their children:

PRIEST THAAHWAM 3: Psalms 78:7 That they might set their hope in God, and not forget the works of God, but keep his commandments:

PRIEST THAAHWAM 3: Psalms 78:8 And might not be as their fathers, a stubborn and rebellious generation; a generation that set not their heart aright, and whose spirit was not stedfast with God.

PRIEST THAAHWAM 3: Judges 2:10 And also all that generation were gathered unto their fathers: and there arose another generation after them, which knew not the LORD, nor yet the works which he had done for Israel.

PRIEST THAAHWAM 3: Judges 2:11 And the children of Israel did evil in the sight of the LORD, and served Baalim:

PRIEST THAAHWAM 3: Judges 2:12 And they forsook the LORD God of their fathers, which brought them out of the land of Egypt, and followed other gods, of the gods of the people that were round about them, and bowed themselves unto them, and provoked the LORD to anger.

PRIEST THAAHWAM 3: Deuteronomy 7:2 And when the LORD thy God shall deliver them before thee; thou shalt smite them, and utterly destroy them; thou shalt make no covenant with them, nor show mercy unto them:

PRIEST THAAHWAM 3: Deuteronomy 7:3 Neither shalt thou make marriages with them; thy daughter thou shalt not give unto his son, nor his daughter shalt thou take unto thy son.

PRIEST THAAHWAM 3: Deuteronomy 7:4 For they will turn away thy son from following me, that they may serve other gods: so will the anger of the LORD be kindled against you, and destroy thee suddenly.

PRIEST THAAHWAM 3: Deuteronomy 7:5 But thus shall ye deal with them; ye shall destroy their altars, and break down their images, and cut down their groves, and burn their graven images with fire.

PRIEST THAAHWAM 3: Deuteronomy 7:6 For thou art an holy people unto the LORD thy God: the LORD thy God hath chosen thee to be a special people unto himself, above all people that are upon the face of the earth.

PRIEST THAAHWAM 3: Psalms 96:5 For all the gods of the nations are idols: but the LORD made the heavens.

PRIEST THAAHWAM 3: Judges 2:12 And they forsook the LORD God of their fathers, which brought them out of the land of Egypt, and followed other gods, of the gods of the people that were round about them, and bowed themselves unto them, and provoked the LORD to anger.

PRIEST THAAHWAM 3: Judges 2:13 And they forsook the LORD, and served Baal and Ashtaroth.

PRIEST THAAHWAM 3: Judges 2:14 And the anger of the LORD was hot against Israel, and he delivered them into the hands of spoilers that spoiled them, and he sold them into the hands of their enemies round about, so that they could not any longer stand before their enemies.

PRIEST THAAHWAM 3: Judges 2:16 Nevertheless the LORD raised up judges, which delivered them out of the hand of those that spoiled them.

PRIEST THAAHWAM 3: Judges 2:17 And yet they would not hearken unto their judges, but they went a whoring after other gods, and bowed themselves unto them: they turned quickly out of the way which their fathers walked in, obeying the commandments of the LORD; but they did not so.

PRIEST THAAHWAM 3: Judges 2:18 And when the LORD raised them up judges, then the LORD was with the judge, and delivered them out of the hand of their enemies all the days of the judge: for it repented the LORD because of their groanings by reason of them that oppressed them and vexed them.

PRIEST THAAHWAM 3: Judges 2:19 And it came to pass, when the judge was dead, that they returned, and corrupted themselves more than their fathers, in following other gods to serve them, and to bow down unto them; they ceased not from their own doings, nor from their stubborn way.

PRIEST THAAHWAM 3: Judges 2:21 I also will not henceforth drive out any from before them of the nations which Joshua left when he died:

PRIEST THAAHWAM 3: Judges 2:22 That through them I may prove Israel, whether they will keep the way of the LORD to walk therein, as their fathers did keep it, or not.

PRIEST THAAHWAM 3: Judges 2:23 Therefore the LORD left those nations, without driving them out hastily; neither delivered he them into the hand of Joshua.

PRIEST THAAHWAM 3: Judges 3:1 Now these are the nations which the LORD left, to prove Israel by them, even as many of Israel as had not known all the wars of Canaan;

PRIEST THAAHWAM 3: Judges 3:2 Only that the generations of the children of Israel might know, to teach them war, at the least such as before knew nothing thereof;

PRIEST THAAHWAM 3: Judges 3:3 Namely, five lords of the Philistines, and all the Canaanites, and the Sidonians, and the Hivites that dwelt in mount Lebanon, from mount Baalhermon unto the entering in of Hamath.

PRIEST THAAHWAM 3: Judges 3:4 And they were to prove Israel by them, to know whether they would hearken unto the commandments of the LORD, which he commanded their fathers by the hand of Moses.

PRIEST THAAHWAM 3: Judges 3:5 And the children of Israel dwelt among the Canaanites, Hittites, and Amorites, and Perizzites, and Hivites, and Jebusites:

PRIEST THAAHWAM 3: Judges 3:6 And they took their daughters to be their wives, and gave their daughters to their sons, and served their gods.

PRIEST THAAHWAM 3: Judges 3:7 And the children of Israel did evil in the sight of

the LORD, and forgot the LORD their God, and served Baalim and the groves.
PRIEST THAAHWAM 3: Judges 3:8 Therefore the anger of the LORD was hot against Israel, and he sold them into the hand of Chushanrishathaim king of Mesopotamia: and the children of Israel served Chushanrishathaim eight years.

PRIEST THAAHWAM 3: Judges 3:9 And when the children of Israel cried unto the LORD, the LORD raised up a deliverer to the children of Israel, who delivered them, even Othniel the son of Kenaz, Caleb's younger brother.

PRIEST THAAHWAM 3: Judges 3:10 And the Spirit of the LORD came upon him, and he judged Israel, and went out to war: and the LORD delivered Chushanrishathaim king of Mesopotamia into his hand; and his hand prevailed against Chushanrishathaim.

PRIEST THAAHWAM 3: Judges 3:11 And the land had rest forty years. And Othniel the son of Kenaz died.

PRIEST THAAHWAM 3: Judges 3:12 And the children of Israel did evil again in the sight of the LORD: and the LORD strengthened Eglon the king of Moab against Israel, because they had done evil in the sight of the LORD.

PRIEST THAAHWAM 3: Judges 3:13 And he gathered unto him the children of Ammon and Amalek, and went and smote Israel, and possessed the city of palm trees.

PRIEST THAAHWAM 3: Judges 3:14 So the children of Israel served Eglon the king of Moab eighteen years.

PRIEST THAAHWAM 3: Judges 3:15 But when the children of Israel cried unto the LORD, the LORD raised them up a deliverer, Ehud the son of Gera, a Benjamite, a man lefthanded: and by him the children of Israel sent a present unto Eglon the king of Moab.

PRIEST THAAHWAM 3: Judges 3:16 But Ehud made him a dagger which had two edges, of a cubit length; and he did gird it under his raiment upon his right thigh.

PRIEST THAAHWAM 3: Judges 3:17 And he brought the present unto Eglon king of Moab: and Eglon was a very fat man.

PRIEST THAAHWAM 3: Judges 3:18 And when he had made an end to offer the present, he sent away the people that bare the present.

PRIEST THAAHWAM 3: Judges 3:19 But he himself turned again from the quarries that were by Gilgal, and said, I have a secret errand unto thee, O king: who said, Keep silence. And all that stood by him went out from him.

PRIEST THAAHWAM 3: Judges 3:20 And Ehud came unto him; and he was sitting in a summer parlor, which he had for himself alone. And Ehud said, I have a message from God unto thee. And he arose out of his seat.

PRIEST THAAHWAM 3: Judges 3:21 And Ehud put forth his left hand, and took the dagger from his right thigh, and thrust it into his belly:

PRIEST THAAHWAM 3: Judges 3:22 And the haft also went in after the blade; and the fat closed upon the blade, so that he could not draw the dagger out of his belly; and the dirt came out.

PRIEST THAAHWAM 3: Judges 3:23 Then Ehud went forth through the porch, and shut the doors of the parlor upon him, and locked them.

PRIEST THAAHWAM 3: Judges 3:24 When he was gone out, his servants came; and when they saw that, behold, the doors of the parlor were locked, they said, Surely he covereth his feet in his summer chamber.

PRIEST THAAHWAM 3: Judges 3:25 And they tarried till they were ashamed: and, behold, he opened not the doors of the parlor; therefore they took a key, and opened them: and, behold, their lord was fallen down dead on the earth.

PRIEST THAAHWAM 3: Judges 3:26 And Ehud escaped while they tarried, and passed beyond the quarries, and escaped unto Seirath.

PRIEST THAAHWAM 3: Judges 3:27 And it came to pass, when he was come, that he blew a trumpet in the mountain of Ephraim, and the children of Israel went down with him from the mount, and he before them.

PRIEST THAAHWAM 3: Judges 3:28 And he said unto them, Follow after me: for the LORD hath delivered your enemies the Moabites into your hand. And they went down after him, and took the fords of Jordan toward Moab, and suffered not a man to pass over.

PRIEST THAAHWAM 3: Judges 3:29 And they slew of Moab at that time about ten thousand men, all lusty, and all men of valour; and there escaped not a man.

PRIEST THAAHWAM 3: Judges 3:30 So Moab was subdued that day under the hand of Israel. And the land had rest fourscore years.

PRIEST THAAHWAM 3: Judges 3:31 And after him was Shamgar the son of Anath, which slew of the Philistines six hundred men with an ox goad: and he also delivered Israel.

PRIEST THAAHWAM 3: Judges 4:1 And the children of Israel again did evil in the sight of the LORD, when Ehud was dead.

PRIEST THAAHWAM 3: Judges 4:2 And the LORD sold them into the hand of Jabin king of Canaan, that reigned in Hazor; the captain of whose host was Sisera, which dwelt in Harosheth of the Gentiles.

PRIEST THAAHWAM 3: Judges 4:3 And the children of Israel cried unto the LORD: for he had nine hundred chariots of iron; and twenty years he mightily oppressed the children of Israel.

PRIEST THAAHWAM 3: Judges 4:4 And Deborah, a prophetess, the wife of Lapidoth, she judged Israel at that time.

PRIEST THAAHWAM 3: Judges 4:5 And she dwelt under the palm tree of Deborah between Ramah and Bethel in mount Ephraim: and the children of Israel came up to her for judgment.

PRIEST THAAHWAM 3: Judges 4:6 And she sent and called Barak the son of Abinoam out of Kedeshnaphtali, and said unto him, Hath not the LORD God of Israel commanded, saying, Go and draw toward mount Tabor, and take with thee ten thousand men of the children of Naphtali and of the children of Zebulun?

PRIEST THAAHWAM 3: Judges 4:7 And I will draw unto thee to the river Kishon Sisera, the captain of Jabin's army, with his chariots and his multitude; and I will deliver him into thine hand.

PRIEST THAAHWAM 3: Judges 13:1 And the children of Israel did evil again in the sight of the LORD; and the LORD delivered them into the hand of the Philistines forty years.

PRIEST THAAHWAM 3: Judges 10:10 And the children of Israel cried unto the LORD, saying, We have sinned against thee, both because we have forsaken our God, and also served Baalim.

PRIEST THAAHWAM 3: Judges 10:11 And the LORD said unto the children of Israel, Did not I deliver you from the Egyptians, and from the Amorites, from the children of Ammon, and from the Philistines?

PRIEST THAAHWAM 3: Judges 10:12 The Zidonians also, and the Amalekites, and the Maonites, did oppress you; and ye cried to me, and I delivered you out of their hand.

PRIEST THAAHWAM 3: Judges 10:13 Yet ye have forsaken me, and served other gods: wherefore I will deliver you no more.

PRIEST THAAHWAM 3: Judges 10:14 Go and cry unto the gods which ye have chosen; let them deliver you in the time of your tribulation.

PRIEST THAAHWAM 3: Judges 10:15 And the children of Israel said unto the LORD, We have sinned: do thou unto us whatsoever seemeth good unto thee; deliver us only, we pray thee, this day.

PRIEST THAAHWAM 3: Judges 10:16 And they put away the strange gods from among them, and served the LORD: and his soul was grieved for the misery of Israel.

PRIEST THAAHWAM 3: 1 Kings 8:14 And the king turned his face about, and blessed all the congregation of Israel: (and all the congregation of Israel stood 😊)

PRIEST THAAHWAM 3: 1 Kings 8:15 And he said, Blessed be the LORD God of Israel, which spake with his mouth unto David my father, and hath with his hand fulfilled it, saying,

PRIEST THAAHWAM 3: 1 Kings 8:16 Since the day that I brought forth my people Israel out of Egypt, I chose no city out of all the tribes of Israel to build an house, that my name might be therein; but I chose David to be over my people Israel.

PRIEST THAAHWAM 3: 1 Kings 8:44 If thy people go out to battle against their enemy, whithersoever thou shalt send them, and shall pray unto the LORD toward the city which thou hast chosen, and toward the house that I have built for thy name:

PRIEST THAAHWAM 3: 1 Kings 8:45 Then hear thou in heaven their prayer and their supplication, and maintain their cause.

PRIEST THAAHWAM 3: 1 Kings 8:46 If they sin against thee, (for there is no man that sinneth not,) and thou be angry with them, and deliver them to the enemy, so that they carry them away captives unto the land of the enemy, far or near;

PRIEST THAAHWAM 3: 1 Kings 8:47 Yet if they shall bethink themselves in the land whither they were carried captives, and repent, and make supplication unto thee in the land of them that carried them captives, saying, We have sinned,

and have done perversely, we have committed wickedness;

PRIEST THAAHWAM 3: 1 Kings 8:48 And so return unto thee with all their heart, and with all their soul, in the land of their enemies, which led them away captive, and pray unto thee toward their land, which thou gavest unto their fathers, the city which thou hast chosen, and the house which I have built for thy name:

PRIEST THAAHWAM 3: 1 Kings 8:49 Then hear thou their prayer and their supplication in heaven thy dwelling place, and maintain their cause,

PRIEST THAAHWAM 3: 1 Kings 8:50 And forgive thy people that have sinned against thee, and all their transgressions wherein they have transgressed against thee, and give them compassion before them who carried them captive, that they may have compassion on them:

PRIEST THAAHWAM 3: 1 Kings 8:51 For they be thy people, and thine inheritance, which thou broughtest forth out of Egypt, from the midst of the furnace of iron:

PRIEST THAAHWAM 3: 1 Kings 8:52 That thine eyes may be open unto the supplication of thy servant, and unto the supplication of thy people Israel, to hearken unto them in all that they call for unto thee.

PRIEST THAAHWAM 3: 1 Kings 8:53 For thou didst separate them from among all the people of the earth, to be thine inheritance, as thou spakest by the hand of Moses thy servant, when thou broughtest our fathers out of Egypt, O LORD God.

PRIEST THAAHWAM 3: 1 Kings 8:54 And it was so, that when Solomon had made an end of praying all this prayer and supplication unto the LORD, he arose from before the altar of the LORD, from kneeling on his knees with his hands spread up to heaven.

PRIEST THAAHWAM 3: 1 Kings 8:55 And he stood, and blessed all the congregation of Israel with a loud voice, saying,

PRIEST THAAHWAM 3: 1 Kings 8:56 Blessed be the LORD, that hath given rest unto his people Israel, according to all that he promised: there hath not failed one word of all his good promise, which he promised by the hand of Moses his servant.

PRIEST THAAHWAM 3: 1 Kings 8:57 The LORD our God be with us, as he was with our fathers: let him not leave us, nor forsake us:

PRIEST THAAHWAM 3: 1 Kings 8:58 That he may incline our hearts unto him, to walk in all his ways, and to keep his commandments, and his statutes, and his judgments, which he commanded our fathers.

PRIEST THAAHWAM 3: 1 Kings 8:59 And let these my words, wherewith I have made supplication before the LORD, be nigh unto the LORD our God day and night, that he maintain the cause of his servant, and the cause of his people Israel at all times, as the matter shall require:

PRIEST THAAHWAM 3: 1 Kings 8:60 That all the people of the earth may know that the LORD is God, and that there is none else.

PRIEST THAAHWAM 3: 1 Kings 8:61 Let your heart therefore be perfect with the

LORD our God, to walk in his statutes, and to keep his commandments, as at this day.

PRIEST THAAHWAM 3: 1 Kings 8:62 And the king, and all Israel with him, offered sacrifice before the LORD.

PRIEST THAAHWAM 3: Luke 21:20 And when ye shall see Jerusalem compassed with armies, then know that the desolation thereof is nigh.

PRIEST THAAHWAM 3: Psalms 79:1 O god, the heathen are come into thine inheritance; thy holy temple have they defiled; they have laid Jerusalem on heaps.

PRIEST THAAHWAM 3: Psalms 79:2 The dead bodies of thy servants have they given to be meat unto the fowls of the heaven, the flesh of thy saints unto the beasts of the earth.

PRIEST THAAHWAM 3: Psalms 79:3 Their blood have they shed like water round about Jerusalem; and there was none to bury them.

PRIEST THAAHWAM 3: Psalms 79:4 We are become a reproach to our neighbours, a scorn and derision to them that are round about us.

PRIEST THAAHWAM 3: Psalms 78:1 Give ear, O my people, to my law: incline your ears to the words of my mouth.

PRIEST THAAHWAM 3: Psalms 78:5 For he established a testimony in Jacob, and appointed a law in Israel, which he commanded our fathers, that they should make them known to their children:

PRIEST THAAHWAM 3: Psalms 78:6 That the generation to come might know them, even the children which should be born; who should arise and declare them to their children:

PRIEST THAAHWAM 3: Joel 3:4 Yea, and what have ye to do with me, O Tyre, and Zidon, and all the coasts of Palestine? will ye render me a recompence? and if ye recompense me, swiftly and speedily will I return your recompence upon your own head;

PRIEST THAAHWAM 3: Joel 3:6 The children also of Judah and the children of Jerusalem have ye sold unto the Grecians, that ye might remove them far from their border.

PRIEST THAAHWAM 3: Joel 3:3 And they have cast lots for my people; and have given a boy for an harlot, and sold a girl for wine, that they might drink.

PRIEST THAAHWAM 3: Luke 21:24 And they shall fall by the edge of the sword, and shall be led away captive into all nations: and Jerusalem shall be trodden down of the Gentiles, until the times of the Gentiles be fulfilled.

PRIEST THAAHWAM 3: Colossians 3:25 But he that doeth wrong shall receive for the wrong which he hath done: and there is no respect of persons.

PRIEST THAAHWAM 3: Galatians 6:7 Be not deceived; God is not mocked: for whatsoever a man soweth, that shall he also reap.

PRIEST THAAHWAM 3: Revelation 13:9 If any man have an ear, let him hear.

PRIEST THAAHWAM 3: Revelation 13:10 He that leadeth into captivity shall go into captivity: he that killeth with the sword must be killed with the sword. Here is the patience and the faith of the saints.

PRIEST THAAHWAM 3: Jeremiah 30:16 Therefore all they that devour thee shall be devoured; and all thine adversaries, every one of them, shall go into captivity; and they that spoil thee shall be a spoil, and all that prey upon thee will I give for a prey.
