

# FEAST OF TRUMPET & NEW MOON - September 9, 2010

**Colossians 3:17** And whatsoever ye do in word or deed, do all in the name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks to God and the Father by him.

**Numbers 10:10** Also in the day of your gladness, and in your solemn days, and in the beginnings of your months, ye shall blow with the trumpets over your burnt offerings, and over the sacrifices of your peace offerings; that they may be to you for a memorial before your God: I am the LORD your God.

**Romans 12:1** I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that ye present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable unto God, which is your reasonable service.

**Daniel 4:17** This matter is by the decree of the watchers, and the demand by the word of the holy ones: to the intent that the living may know that the most High ruleth in the kingdom of men, and giveth it to whomsoever he will, and setteth up over it the basest of men.

**Psalms 81:1** Sing aloud unto God our strength: make a joyful noise unto the God of Jacob.

**Psalms 81:2** Take a psalm, and bring hither the timbrel, the pleasant harp with the psaltery.

**Psalms 81:3** Blow up the trumpet in the new moon, in the time appointed, on our solemn feast day.

**Psalms 81:4** For this was a statute for Israel, and a law of the God of Jacob.

**Psalms 81:5** This he ordained in Joseph for a testimony, when he went out through the land of Egypt: where I heard a language that I understood not.

**Psalms 81:6** I removed his shoulder from the burden: his hands were delivered from the pots.

**Psalms 81:7** Thou calledst in trouble, and I delivered thee; I answered thee in the secret place of thunder: I proved thee at the waters of Meribah. Selah.

**Psalms 81:8** Hear, O my people, and I will testify unto thee: O Israel, if thou wilt hearken unto me;

**Hosea 5:15** I will go and return to my place, till they acknowledge their offence, and seek my face: in their affliction they will seek me early.

**Deuteronomy 32:16** They provoked him to jealousy with strange gods, with abominations provoked they him to anger.

**Psalms 51:16** For thou desirest not sacrifice; else would I give it: thou delightest not in burnt offering.

**Psalms 51:17** The sacrifices of God are a broken spirit: a broken and a contrite heart, O God, thou wilt not despise.

**Deuteronomy 32:16** They provoked him to jealousy with strange gods, with abominations provoked they him to anger.

**Deuteronomy 32:17** They sacrificed unto devils, not to God; to gods whom they knew not, to new gods that came newly up, whom your fathers feared not.

**Deuteronomy 32:18** Of the Rock that begat thee thou art unmindful, and hast forgotten God that formed thee.

## [PRECEPT]

**1 Corinthians 10:4** And did all drink the same spiritual drink: for they drank of that spiritual Rock that followed them: and that Rock was Christ.

**Judges 10:10** And the children of Israel cried unto the LORD, saying, We have sinned against thee, both because we have forsaken our God, and also served Baalim.

**Judges 10:11** And the LORD said unto the children of Israel, Did not I deliver you from the Egyptians, and from the Amorites, from the children of Ammon, and from the Philistines?

**Judges 10:12** The Zidonians also, and the Amalekites, and the Maonites, did oppress you; and ye cried to me, and I delivered you out of their hand.

**Proverbs 16:18** Pride goeth before destruction, and an haughty spirit before a fall.

**Isaiah 1:3** The ox knoweth his owner, and the ass his master's crib: but Israel doth not know, my people doth not consider.

**Leviticus 23:23** And the LORD spake unto Moses, saying,

**Leviticus 23:24** Speak unto the children of Israel, saying, In the seventh month, in the first day of the month, shall ye have a sabbath, a memorial of blowing of trumpets, an holy convocation.

**Leviticus 23:25** Ye shall do no servile work therein: but ye shall offer an offering made by fire unto the LORD.

## [PRECEPT]

**Jeremiah 23:29** Is not my word like as a fire? saith the LORD; and like a hammer that breaketh the rock in pieces?

**Hebrews 4:12** For the word of God is quick, and powerful, and sharper than any twoedged sword, piercing even to the dividing asunder of soul and spirit, and of the joints and marrow, and is a discerner of the thoughts and intents of the heart.

**1 Thessalonians 4:14** For if we believe that Jesus died and rose again, even so them also which sleep in Jesus will God bring with him.

**1 Thessalonians 4:15** For this we say unto you by the word of the Lord, that we which are alive and remain unto the coming of the Lord shall not prevent them which are asleep.

**1 Thessalonians 4:16** For the Lord himself shall descend from heaven with a shout, with the voice of the archangel, and with the trump of God: and the dead in Christ shall rise first:

## [PRECEPT]

**Revelation 1:7** Behold, he cometh with clouds; and every eye shall see him, and they also which pierced him: and all kindreds of the earth shall wail because of him. Even so, Amen.

**1 Thessalonians 4:16** For the Lord himself shall descend from heaven with a shout, with the voice of the archangel, and with the trump of God: and the dead in Christ shall rise first:

[2 Esdras 16:13](#) For strong is his right hand that bendeth the bow, his arrows that he shooteth are sharp, and shall not miss, when they begin to be shot into the ends of the world.

[2 Esdras 16:14](#) Behold, the plagues are sent, and shall not return again, until they come upon the earth.

[2 Esdras 16:15](#) The fire is kindled, and shall not be put out, till it consume the foundation of the earth.

[2 Esdras 16:16](#) Like as an arrow which is shot of a mighty archer returneth not backward: even so the plagues that shall be sent upon earth shall not return again.

[2 Esdras 16:17](#) Woe is me! woe is me! who will deliver me in those days?

[2 Esdras 16:18](#) The beginning of sorrows and great mournings; the beginning of famine and great death; the beginning of wars, and the powers shall stand in fear; the beginning of evils! what shall I do when these evils shall come?

**Revelation 11:15** And the seventh angel sounded; and there were great voices in heaven,

saying, The kingdoms of this world are become the kingdoms of our Lord, and of his Christ; and he shall reign for ever and ever.

**Revelation 11:16** And the four and twenty elders, which sat before God on their seats, fell upon their faces, and worshipped God,

**Revelation 11:17** Saying, We give thee thanks, O Lord God Almighty, which art, and wast, and art to come; because thou hast taken to thee thy great power, and hast reigned.

**Revelation 11:18** And the nations were angry, and thy wrath is come, and the time of the dead, that they should be judged, and that thou shouldest give reward unto thy servants the prophets, and to the saints, and them that fear thy name, small and great; and shouldest destroy them which destroy the earth.

**Job 39:24** He swalloweth the ground with fierceness and rage: neither believeth he that it is the sound of the trumpet.

**Job 39:25** He saith among the trumpets, Ha, ha; and he smelleth the battle afar off, the thunder of the captains, and the shouting.

**Jeremiah 4:19** My bowels, my bowels! I am pained at my very heart; my heart maketh a noise in me; I cannot hold my peace, because thou hast heard, O my soul, the sound of the trumpet, the alarm of war.

**Jeremiah 4:20** Destruction upon destruction is cried; for the whole land is spoiled: suddenly are my tents spoiled, and my curtains in a moment.

**Jeremiah 4:21** How long shall I see the standard, and hear the sound of the trumpet?

**Jeremiah 4:22** For my people is foolish, they have not known me; they are sottish children, and they have none understanding: they are wise to do evil, but to do good they have no knowledge.

**Joel 2:1** Blow ye the trumpet in Zion, and sound an alarm in my holy mountain: let all the inhabitants of the land tremble: for the day of the LORD cometh, for it is nigh at hand;

**Joel 2:2** A day of darkness and of gloominess, a day of clouds and of thick darkness, as the morning spread upon the mountains: a great people and a strong; there hath not been ever the like, neither shall be any more after it, even to the years of many generations.

**Joel 2:3** A fire devoureth before them; and behind them a flame burneth: the land is as the garden of Eden before them, and behind them a desolate wilderness; yea, and nothing shall escape them.

**Joel 2:4** The appearance of them is as the appearance of horses; and as horsemen, so shall they run.

**Joel 2:5** Like the noise of chariots on the tops of mountains shall they leap, like the noise of a flame of fire that devoureth the stubble, as a strong people set in battle array.

**Joel 2:6** Before their face the people shall be much pained: all faces shall gather blackness.

**Joel 2:7** They shall run like mighty men; they shall climb the wall like men of war; and they shall march every one on his ways, and they shall not break their ranks:

**Joel 2:8** Neither shall one thrust another; they shall walk every one in his path: and when they fall upon the sword, they shall not be wounded.

**Joel 2:9** They shall run to and fro in the city; they shall run upon the wall, they shall climb up upon the houses; they shall enter in at the windows like a thief.

**Joel 2:10** The earth shall quake before them; the heavens shall tremble: the sun and the moon shall be dark, and the stars shall withdraw their shining:

**Joel 2:11** And the LORD shall utter his voice before his army: for his camp is very great: for he is strong that executeth his word: for the day of the LORD is great and very terrible; and who can abide it?

**Joel 2:12** Therefore also now, saith the LORD, turn ye even to me with all your heart, and with fasting, and with weeping, and with mourning:

**Joel 2:13** And rend your heart, and not your garments, and turn unto the LORD your God: for he is gracious and merciful, slow to anger, and of great kindness, and repenteth him of the evil.

**Joel 2:14** Who knoweth if he will return and repent, and leave a blessing behind him; even a

meat offering and a drink offering unto the LORD your God?

**Joel 2:15** Blow the trumpet in Zion, sanctify a fast, call a solemn assembly:
