

## Prayer – Fasting – Faith

**Colossians 3:17** And whatsoever ye do in word or deed, do all in the name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks to God and the Father by him.

**Hebrews 11:6** But without faith it is impossible to please him: for he that cometh to God must believe that he is, and that he is a rewarder of them that diligently seek him.

**Hebrews 11:17** By faith Abraham, when he was tried, offered up Isaac: and he that had received the promises offered up his only begotten son,

**Hebrews 11:24** By faith Moses, when he was come to years, refused to be called the son of Pharaoh's daughter;

**Hebrews 11:25** Choosing rather to suffer affliction with the people of God, than to enjoy the pleasures of sin for a season;

**Hebrews 11:26** Esteeming the reproach of Christ greater riches than the treasures in Egypt: for he had respect unto the recompence of the reward.

**Religion (comes from the word Religio) = Hold Back, Keep Back and Restrained**

**Hebrews 11:31** By faith the harlot Rahab perished not with them that believed not, when she had received the spies with peace.

**Hebrews 11:35** Women received their dead raised to life again: and others were tortured, not accepting deliverance; that they might obtain a better resurrection:

**Hebrews 11:36** And others had trial of cruel mockings and scourgings, yea, moreover of bonds and imprisonment:

**Hebrews 11:37** They were stoned, they were sawn asunder, were tempted, were slain with the sword: they wandered about in sheepskins and goatskins; being destitute, afflicted, tormented;

**Hebrews 11:38** (Of whom the world was not worthy:) they wandered in deserts, and in mountains, and in dens and caves of the earth.

**Hebrews 11:39** And these all, having obtained a good report through faith, received not the promise:

**Hebrews 11:40** God having provided some better thing for us, that they without us should not be made perfect.

**Matthew 7:21** Not every one that saith unto me, Lord, Lord, shall enter into the kingdom of heaven; but he that doeth the will of my Father which is in heaven.

**Matthew 7:22** Many will say to me in that day, Lord, Lord, have we not prophesied in thy name? and in thy name have cast out devils? and in thy name done many wonderful works?

**Matthew 7:23** And then will I profess unto them, I never knew you: depart from me, ye that work iniquity.

**Hebrews 2:7** Thou madest him a little lower than the angels; thou crownedst him with glory and honour, and didst set him over the works of thy hands:

**Hebrews 2:8** Thou hast put all things in subjection under his feet. For in that he put all in subjection under him, he left nothing that is not put under him. But now we see not yet all things put under him.

**Hebrews 2:9** But we see Jesus, who was made a little lower than the angels for the suffering of death, crowned with glory and honour; that he by the grace of God should taste death for every man.

**Hebrews 2:10** For it became him, for whom are all things, and by whom are all things, in bringing many sons unto glory, to make the captain of their salvation perfect through sufferings.

**Hebrews 2:11** For both he that sanctifieth and they who are sanctified are all of one: for which

cause he is not ashamed to call them brethren,

**Hebrews 2:12** Saying, I will declare thy name unto my brethren, in the midst of the church will I sing praise unto thee.

**Titus 1:16** They profess that they know God; but in works they deny him, being abominable, and disobedient, and unto every good work reprobate.

**Galatians 6:3** For if a man think himself to be something, when he is nothing, he deceiveth himself.

**Galatians 6:4** But let every man prove his own work, and then shall he have rejoicing in himself alone, and not in another.

**Galatians 6:5** For every man shall bear his own burden.

**Galatians 6:7** Be not deceived; God is not mocked: for whatsoever a man soweth, that shall he also reap.

**Matthew 16:24** Then said Jesus unto his disciples, If any man will come after me, let him deny himself, and take up his cross, and follow me.

[PRECEPT]-----

**John 5:30** I can of mine own self do nothing: as I hear, I judge: and my judgment is just; because I seek not mine own will, but the will of the Father which hath sent me.

**John 5:31** If I bear witness of myself, my witness is not true.

**John 5:32** There is another that beareth witness of me; and I know that the witness which he witnesseth of me is true.

**John 5:34** But I receive not testimony from man: but these things I say, that ye might be saved.

**Philippians 2:5** Let this mind be in you, which was also in Christ Jesus:

**Philippians 2:6** Who, being in the form of God, thought it not robbery to be equal with God:

**Philippians 2:7** But made himself of no reputation, and took upon him the form of a servant, and was made in the likeness of men:

**Philippians 2:8** And being found in fashion as a man, he humbled himself, and became obedient unto death, even the death of the cross.

**Matthew 16:24** Then said Jesus unto his disciples, If any man will come after me, let him deny himself, and take up his cross, and follow me.

**Matthew 16:25** For whosoever will save his life shall lose it: and whosoever will lose his life for my sake shall find it.

**Matthew 16:26** For what is a man profited, if he shall gain the whole world, and lose his own soul? or what shall a man give in exchange for his soul?

**Matthew 16:27** For the Son of man shall come in the glory of his Father with his angels; and then he shall reward every man according to his works.

**Revelation 14:12** **Here is the patience of the saints:** here are they that keep the commandments of God, and the **faith** of Jesus.

**Galatians 2:16** Knowing that a man is not justified by the works of the law, but by the faith of Jesus Christ, even we have believed in Jesus Christ, that we might be justified by the faith of Christ, and not by the works of the law: for by the works of the law shall no flesh be justified.

**Philippians 2:3** Let nothing be done through strife or vainglory; but in lowliness of mind let each

esteem other better than themselves.

**Philippians 2:4** Look not every man on his own things, but every man also on the things of others.

**Philippians 2:5** Let this mind be in you, which was also in Christ Jesus:

[PRECEPT]-----

**Nehemiah 1:2** That Hanani, one of my brethren, came, he and certain men of Judah; and I asked them concerning the Jews that had escaped, which were left of the captivity, and concerning Jerusalem.

**Nehemiah 1:3** And they said unto me, The remnant that are left of the captivity there in the province are in great affliction and reproach: the wall of Jerusalem also is broken down, and the gates thereof are burned with fire.

**Nehemiah 1:4** And it came to pass, when I heard these words, that I sat down and wept, and mourned certain days, and fasted, and prayed before the God of heaven,

**Nehemiah 1:5** And said, I beseech thee, O LORD God of heaven, the great and terrible God, that keepeth covenant and mercy for them that love him and observe his commandments:

**Nehemiah 1:6** Let thine ear now be attentive, and thine eyes open, that thou mayest hear the prayer of thy servant, which I pray before thee now, day and night, for the children of Israel thy servants, and confess the sins of the children of Israel, which we have sinned against thee: both I and my father's house have sinned.

**Nehemiah 1:7** We have dealt very corruptly against thee, and have not kept the commandments, nor the statutes, nor the judgments, which thou commandedst thy servant Moses.

**Acts 15:1** And certain men which came down from Judaea taught the brethren, and said, Except ye be circumcised after the manner of Moses, ye cannot be saved.

**Acts 15:2** When therefore Paul and Barnabas had no small dissension and disputation with them, they determined that Paul and Barnabas, and certain other of them, should go up to Jerusalem unto the apostles and elders about this question.

**Acts 15:3** And being brought on their way by the church, they passed through Phenice and Samaria, declaring the conversion of the Gentiles: and they caused great joy unto all the brethren.

**Acts 15:4** And when they were come to Jerusalem, they were received of the church, and of the apostles and elders, and they declared all things that God had done with them.

**Acts 15:5** But there rose up certain of the sect of the Pharisees which believed, saying, That it was needful to circumcise them, and to command them to keep the law of Moses.

**Acts 15:6** And the apostles and elders came together for to consider of this matter.

**Acts 15:7** And when there had been much disputing, Peter rose up, and said unto them, Men and brethren, ye know how that a good while ago God made choice among us, that the Gentiles by my mouth should hear the word of the gospel, and believe.

**Acts 15:8** And God, which knoweth the hearts, bare them witness, giving them the Holy Ghost, even as he did unto us;

**Acts 15:9** And put no difference between us and them, purifying their hearts by faith.

**Acts 15:10** Now therefore why tempt ye God, to put a yoke upon the neck of the disciples, which neither our fathers nor we were able to bear?

**Acts 15:11** But we believe that through the grace of the Lord Jesus Christ we shall be saved, even as they.

**Acts 15:12** Then all the multitude kept silence, and gave audience to Barnabas and Paul, declaring what miracles and wonders God had wrought among the Gentiles by them.

**Acts 15:13** And after they had held their peace, James answered, saying, Men and brethren, hearken unto me:

**Acts 15:14** Simeon hath declared how God at the first did visit the Gentiles, to take out of them a

people for his name.

**Acts 15:15** And to this agree the words of the prophets; as it is written,

**Acts 15:16** After this I will return, and will build again the tabernacle of David, which is fallen down; and I will build again the ruins thereof, and I will set it up:

**Acts 15:17** That the residue of men might seek after the Lord, and all the Gentiles, upon whom my name is called, saith the Lord, who doeth all these things.

**Acts 15:18** Known unto God are all his works from the beginning of the world.

**Acts 15:19** Wherefore my sentence is, that we trouble not them, which from among the Gentiles are turned to God:

**Acts 15:20** But that we write unto them, that they abstain from pollutions of idols, and from fornication, and from things strangled, and from blood.

**Acts 15:21** For Moses of old time hath in every city them that preach him, being read in the synagogues every sabbath day.

**Acts 15:22** Then pleased it the apostles and elders with the whole church, to send chosen men of their own company to Antioch with Paul and Barnabas; namely, Judas surnamed Barsabas and Silas, chief men among the brethren:

**Acts 15:23** And they wrote letters by them after this manner; The apostles and elders and brethren send greeting unto the brethren which are of the Gentiles in Antioch and Syria and Cilicia.

**Acts 15:24** Forasmuch as we have heard, that certain which went out from us have troubled you with words, subverting your souls, saying, Ye must be circumcised, and keep the law: to whom we gave no such commandment:

**Acts 15:25** It seemed good unto us, being assembled with one accord, to send chosen men unto you with our beloved Barnabas and Paul,

**Acts 15:26** Men that have hazarded their lives for the name of our Lord Jesus Christ.

**Acts 15:27** We have sent therefore Judas and Silas, who shall also tell you the same things by mouth.

**Acts 15:28** For it seemed good to the Holy Ghost, and to us, to lay upon you no greater burden than these necessary things;

**Acts 15:29** That ye abstain from meats offered to idols, and from blood, and from things strangled, and from fornication: from which if ye keep yourselves, ye shall do well. Fare ye well.

**Matthew 5:16** Let your light so shine before men, that they may see your good works, and glorify your Father which is in heaven.

**Matthew 5:17** Think not that I am come to destroy the law, or the prophets: I am not come to destroy, but to fulfil.

**Matthew 5:18** For verily I say unto you, Till heaven and earth pass, one jot or one tittle shall in no wise pass from the law, till all be fulfilled.

**Matthew 5:19** Whosoever therefore shall break one of these least commandments, and shall teach men so, he shall be called the least in the kingdom of heaven: but whosoever shall do and teach them, the same shall be called great in the kingdom of heaven.

**Matthew 5:20** For I say unto you, That except your righteousness shall exceed the righteousness of the scribes and Pharisees, ye shall in no case enter into the kingdom of heaven.

**Matthew 17:14 And when they were come to the multitude, there came to him a certain man, kneeling down to him, and saying.**

**Matthew 17:15 Lord, have mercy on my son: for he is lunatick, and sore vexed: for oftentimes he falleth into the fire, and oft into the water.**

**Matthew 17:16 And I brought him to thy disciples, and they could not cure him.**

**Matthew 17:17 Then Jesus answered and said, O faithless and perverse generation, how long shall I be with you? how long shall I suffer you? bring him hither to me.**

**Matthew 17:18 And Jesus rebuked the devil; and he departed out of him: and the child was cured from that very hour.**

**Matthew 17:19 Then came the disciples to Jesus apart, and said, Why could not we cast him out?**

Matthew 17:20 And Jesus said unto them, Because of your unbelief: for verily I say unto you, If ye have faith as a grain of mustard seed, ye shall say unto this mountain, Remove hence to yonder place; and it shall remove; and nothing shall be impossible unto you.  
Matthew 17:21 Howbeit this kind goeth not out but by prayer and fasting.
