[The Book of Baruch 4:1](#) This is the book of the commandments of God, and the law that endureth for ever: all they that keep it shall come to life; but such as leave it shall die.

[Ecclesiasticus 19:27](#) Casting down his countenance, and making as if he heard not: where he is not known, he will do thee a mischief before thou be aware.

[Ecclesiasticus 19:28](#) And if for want of power he be hindered from sinning, yet when he findeth opportunity he will do evil.
