TEN COMMANDMENTS:

Exodus 20:14 Thou shalt not commit adultery.

Exodus 20:15 Thou shalt not steal.

Exodus 20:16 Thou shalt not bear false witness against thy neighbour.

Exodus 20:17 Thou shalt not covet thy neighbour's house, thou shalt not covet thy neighbour's wife, nor his manservant, nor his maidservant, nor his ox, nor his ass, nor any thing that is thy neighbour's.

[Sirach 19:13](#) Admonish a friend, it may be he hath not done it: and if he have done it, that he do it

no more.

[Sirach 19:14](#) Admonish thy friend, it may be he hath not said it: and if he have, that he speak it not again.

[Sirach 19:15](#) Admonish a friend: for many times it is a slander, and believe not every tale.

[Sirach 19:16](#) There is one that slippeth in his speech, but not from his heart; and who is he that hath not offended with his tongue?

[Sirach 19:17](#) Admonish thy neighbour before thou threaten him; and not being angry, give place to the law of the most High.

DEALING WITH A CONFLICT IN DECENCY AND ORDER BETWEEN YOUR FELLOW ISRAELITE
